

DDG (NRM) Visits LRI Soil Survey Site in Bundelkhand Region on 08.10.2021

Dr. S.K. Chaudhari, Deputy Director General (NRM), ICAR visited Jhansi, Datia and surrounding Bundelkhand region. He reviewed the field work under ongoing research project “Land Resource Inventory (LRI) of Bundelkhand Region for Sustainable Land Use Planning. Dr. Chaudhari visited the soils profile study site located at IISWC, Datia farm on 8-10-2021. Team of scientists led by Dr. Jaya N. Surya, Pr. Scientist & Head, Regional Centre, Delhi, explained the soil profile details. The discussion during this interaction mostly focussed on different soils in the Bundelkhand region, their constraints / potential for management.
